## Co-op

- **Archival Assistant** – Organizes and prepares historical material for archivist.
- **Assistant Stage Manager** – Relays cues to the back-stage crews and monitors the actors before and during the show all while maintaining consistent communication with stage manager so that they can make informed decisions.
- **Camp Counsellor** – Plans and facilitates age-appropriate activities for children and youth.
- **Costumed Heritage Interpreter** – Tells stories about a historical era while dressed in period costume.
- **Event Planning Assistant** – Assists event planner in organizing events.
- **Gallery Experience Officer** – Plans and organise exhibitions, publicity events and promotional activities such as workshops.
- **Production Assistant** – Serves as a point of contact for all crew and performers to ensure the show runs smoothly.
- **Wardrobe Assistant** – Helps to make, find and look after the costumes used in productions.

## Experiential Education Courses

-  **Advanced Studies in Theatre (DART 4F56)** – Dramatic Arts students work collaboratively in one or more theatre productions.
-  **Advanced Video Art (VISA 3P10)** – Visual Arts students participate in a field experience at a video art show in Toronto, then produce their own video artwork to be showcased to the public in a creative exhibit at the end of the term.
-  **French Internship (FREN 4P05)** – French Studies students complete a 50-hour internship in a business where French is used. Internship settings may include health care, tourism, translation, community services and business.
-  **Game Production I (BTGD 3Y55)** – GAME students work together to conceive, design, document and prototype a new game concept.
-  **Global Education: Field Placement (EDUC 4P36)** – Education students travel to Guatemala to learn from Maya indigenous communities and observe their educational practices.
-  **Innovations in Advanced Digital Media (IASC 3F91)** – Interactive Arts and Science students produce their own video artwork to be showcased to the public in a creative exhibit at the end of the term.
-  **Internship in Communication, Popular Culture or Film (FILM/COMM/PCUL 4F00)** – Communications, Popular Culture and Film students complete a 160-hour internship related to their field of study in a company, agency or not-for-profit organization.
- **Introduction to Digital Film Production (FILM 2F98)** – Students interested in film production are introduced to the theory and practice of digital film techniques to then produce their own creative piece.
- **Introductions to 3D Modelling and Animation (STAC/COSC/VISA 2P96)** – Studies in Arts and Culture, Computer Science and Visual Arts students explore concepts and skills of 3D modelling by using Autodesk Maya (a 3D computer graphics application).
- **Investigating Photography (VISA 1P20)** – Students interested in photography will participate in field trips and studio/lab work to learn about the basics of digital photography.
-  **Jazz Ensemble I (MUSI 1P78)** – Students interested in jazz music attend weekly rehearsals to prepare for performances (open to non-Music majors).
-  **Making History in Niagara (HIST/CANA 3F02)** – History students research, design and present a proposal for a public history project. Projects may include special exhibits at local museums or libraries, historical information plaques, monuments/memorials, brochures, digital/online exhibits, live performances or other artistic productions.
-  **Study in Mediterranean Lands (CLAS/VISA 3M20-3M29)** – Classics and Visual Arts students experience ancient cultures first-hand by visiting monuments, archaeological sites and museums.
