## Co-op


- **Archival Assistant** – Organizes and prepares historical material for archivist.
- **Costumed Heritage Interpreter** – Tells stories about a historical era while dressed in period costume.
- **Gallery Experience Officer** – Plans and organises exhibitions, publicity events and promotional activities such as workshops.
- **Garden Interpreter** – Educates the public about the plants and collections at a botanical garden.
- **Junior Consultant** – Helps businesses overcome challenges that were a direct result of the COVID-19 pandemic or other economic hardships.
- **Marketing Assistant** – Supports the marketing team with planning, implementing, and monitoring marketing campaigns.
- **Tour Guide** – Informs guests in an entertaining manner about the location that they are touring.
- **Wine Associate** – Makes reservations, gives wine tours, sells products, and provides customer service to guests.
- **Winemaker** – Assists with the production of wine from harvested grapes.


## Experiential Education Courses

 **Basics of Organizational Behaviour and Design (OBHR 2P51)** – Tourism Management students explore topics like motivation, leadership, and group dynamics in an organization through discussing and solving case studies.

 **Croatia Field Course (TOUR/GEOG 3P37)** – Students at Brock and other Canadian universities study at the International Tourism and Hospitality Academy at Sea (ITHAS) over one week in Croatia.

- **Evolution of Tourism in Niagara (TOUR 3P32)** – Tourism Studies students learn about the history and evolution of tourism in the Niagara Peninsula from the arrival of European Settlers through full-day field programs.


 **Field School in Local Historical Archaeology (HIST/CLASS 3M60)** – History and Classics students gain practical experience in site surveying, excavation, recording, and laboratory procedures at a historical site in the Niagara Region.

 **Honours Internship (TOUR/GEOG 4F99)** – Geography and Tourism students complete an internship either under the direction of a faculty member or in a government or private agency.

- **Introduction to Wines (OEVI 1P20)** – Students interested in wine production learn about the principles of wine production while sampling wines from across the world.


 **London Field Course (TOUR/GEOG 3F90)** – Tourism Studies and Geography students go on a two-week trip to

London, England to explore the growth and development of London as a global city.

 **Making History in Niagara (HIST/CANA 3F02)** – History students research, design and present a proposal for a public history project. Projects may include special exhibits at local museums or libraries, historical information plaques, monuments/memorials, brochures, digital/online exhibits, live performances or other artistic productions.

- **Outdoor Recreation Theory and Practices I (RECL 2P16)** – Recreation and Leisure Studies students complete outdoor field experiences where they participate in backpacking, winter camping, rock climbing, canoeing, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing.




- **Sensory Evaluation of Wine (OEVI 4P20)** – Oenology and Viticulture students learn to evaluate different types of wines by using their 5 senses in the sensory evaluation lab located on campus.




 **Study in Mediterranean Lands (CLAS/VISA 3M20-3M29)** – Classics students experience ancient cultures first-hand by visiting monuments, archaeological sites, and museums.




- **Vancouver Field Course (TOUR/GEOG 3Q93)** – Tourism Studies and Geography students go on a one-week trip to Vancouver to learn about the historical geography of Vancouver and the surrounding region.
